## MSCA key features

- Support the training and career development of researchers from all over the world through excellent doctorates, postdoctoral fellowships and collaborative projects
- Stimulating international, inter-sectoral and interdisciplinary cooperation.
  - Participation of non-academic sector, especially industry and SMEs
- > For researchers at every stage of their career
- Support excellent research in all domains (bottom-up approach)
- > Promotion of attractive working and employment conditions (financing rate of up to 100%)
- > Impacting researcher careers, organisations, structures









- Supporting postdoctoral research and careers
- > Any nationality
- Mobility rule
- All research domains
- New mind-sets and approaches to research and innovation through interdisciplinary, inter-sectoral and international experience
- Develop skills needed for academia and beyond
  - Intensify exposure/secondments to training in entities beyond academia
  - Improved guidance towards career development (plan & supervision)









#### Duration:

- **European Fellowships**: 12-24 months (additional up to 6 months for non-academic sector)
- ➤ Global Fellowships: 24 -36 (12-24 outgoing & 12 months mandatory return phase in Europe)
- > One single action:
  - Two destinations: European and Global Postdoctoral Fellowships
  - > Secondments in any country
  - Incentive for additional period of up to 6 months for placements in the non-academic sector
- Managing the increasing demand to maintain high-quality selection & improve success rate
  - Limit research experience (with possible exceptions)
  - Require PhD degree
  - > Restrict resubmissions below quality threshold (in 2022)



#### "Truths" to realize... before starting

The Proposal is NOT a Paper/ Article for a Journal...

It is a... "Marketing/ Sales" pitch of the Research... and...

The Career Development of the Fellow

- so as to receive funding...!
- EC has been doing this for quite a few FPs...
  - Particular Policies and Mandate Backgrounds.
  - Particular Language-Jargon, Structure, Process...
- "Competitive Calls for Proposals"... NOT "Subsidies"...!

**EC** publishes the Call, but

Proposal evaluated by **External Expert Evaluators**...

you "need" both audiences...









#### "Truths" to realize... before starting

- - You need European Added Value...!
  - Pan-European Character... for EU and not "just Country-X".
    - Problem/ Issue attempted to be solved or the technology/ innovation attempted to be developed
    - scale/complexity of the "solutions"
  - > Transnationality, Replicability and Transferability should be the keywords for both the "challenges"/ "problems" addressed, and the "solutions" proposed.
  - Clearly show in the proposal how the issue addressed is of a "Wider Interest" and how the solution proposed indeed has Wide Applicability.

  - > Timely, feasible
  - > IMPACT!
- Fellow
  - Achievements
- Supervisor

  - Experience in guiding Postdocs

## Key Messages

- Bottom up yes, but keep in mind the goals of the EC
- Get feedback from multiple sources
- 5 Strategies for writing in turbulent times
- > From isolation to inspiration: The psychology of writing in communities
- > Re-submissions: evaluators will not know until after the evaluation has been done
- Perseverance: maybe not the 1st time.....but you don't loose, you learn!
